Amarajeevi Potti Sriramulu Death Anniversary

on 15-Dec-2019

Amarajeevi Potti Sriramulu (16 March 1901 – 15 December 1952), was an Indian freedom fighter and revolutionary. Sriramulu is revered as *Amarajeevi* ("Immortal Being") in the Andhra region for his self-sacrifice for the Andhra cause. He became famous for undertaking a [hunger strike](#) for 56 days in support of having a separate state for Andhra Pradesh; he died in the process. His death sparked public rioting and Indian Prime Minister [Jawaharlal Nehru](#) declared the intent of the newly liberated nation to form [Andhra State](#) three days following the death of Sriramulu. He contributed his life to the formation of a separate Telugu-speaking state from the dominant Tamil-speaking state of Madras Presidency (now Tamil Nadu). His struggles led to the formation of a separate Telugu-speaking state called "Andhra Pradesh".

Elaborate arrangements are being made for the 125th birth anniversary celebrations of revolutionary Alluri Sitarama Raju from June 27 to July 4 across the State, Special Chief Secretary (Youth Welfare and Culture) Rajat Bhargava said.

Alluri was born on July 4, 1897 and martyred on May 7, 1924 at a young age of 27 years. On Monday, orders were issued to all the District Collectors to make arrangements for celebration of the birth anniversary on a grand scale.

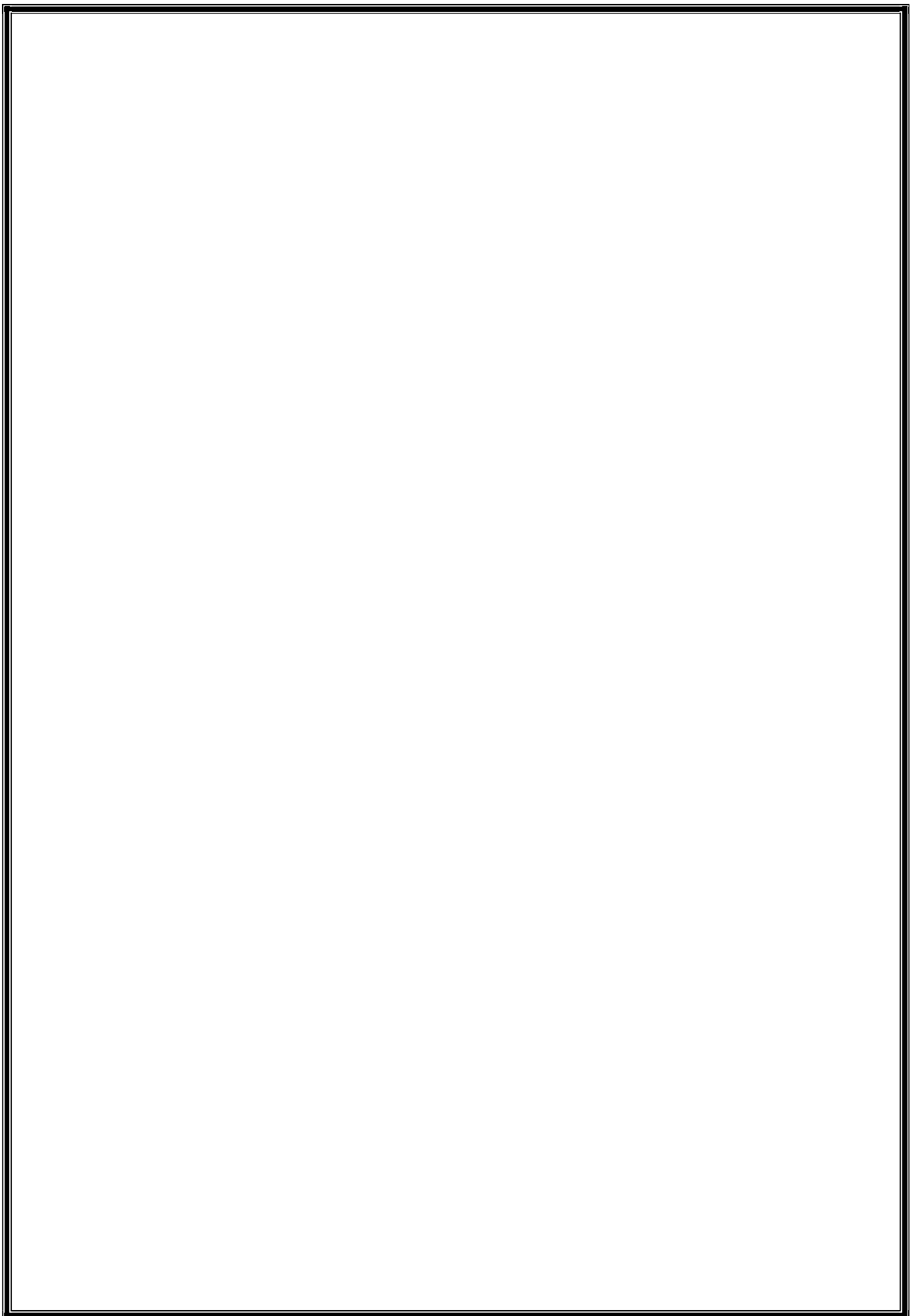

Pingali Venkayya birth anniversary

August 2nd -2022

Pingali Venkayya Birth... Pingali Venkayya birth anniversary: All you need to know about the man who designed India's national flag Pingali Venkayya died on July 4, 1963. His last wish was to wrap the tricolour around his body, which was fulfilled. To celebrate the contributions of Pingali Venkayya, the Ministry of Culture is organising a 'Tiranga Utsav' on his 146th birth anniversary. News Pingali Venkayya was born on August 2, 1878, in Andhra Pradesh. Pingali Venkayya was fluent in Telugu, Hindi, Sanskrit, English, Japanese and Arabic. In 1921, Mahatama Gandhi gave his approval to Venkayya's design for the national flag.

Design of national flag:

The first flag, known as the Swaraj flag, had two red and green bands that stood for the country's two largest religious groups, Hindus and Muslims. A charkha, which stood for Swaraj, was also present on the flag. Venkayya added a white band on Mahatma Gandhi's recommendation. White stood for world peace. Although the All-India Congress Committee (AICC) did not formally recognise the first tricolour, it started to be flown at all Congress events. The flag continued to be used, but it wasn't until 1931 that questions regarding the banner's religious content were brought up. A Flag Committee was formed with this in mind, and they developed a fresh concept known as Purna Swaraj. Saffron was used in place of red and the colours were rearranged such that saffron was on top, followed by white and then green. On the middle white strip, the charkha was positioned. The colours represented values rather than communities; saffron stood for bravery and selflessness, white for righteousness and peace, and green for strength and faith. The charkha advocated for the general welfare of society. When the flag committee gathered in July 1947, it was agreed to utilise the Ashoka Chakra since the "Charkha" (weaving wheel) appeared distinct from the sides (a wheel with 24 spokes). The country had 24 states at the moment of Independence, as shown by the 24 spokes.

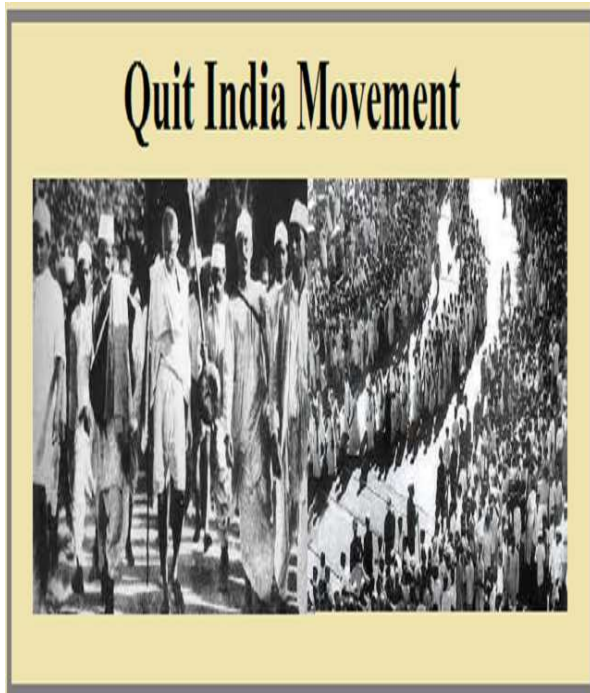
QUIT INDIA MOVEMENT AUGUST 8th– 2022

The **Quit India Movement**, also known as the **August Kranti Movement**, was a movement launched at the Bombay session of the All-India Congress Committee by Mahatma Gandhi on 8th August 1942, during World War II, demanding an end to British rule in India.

After the failure of the Cripps Mission to secure Indian support for the British war effort, Gandhi made a call to *Do or Die* in his Quit India speech delivered in Bombay on 8 August 1942 at the Gowalia Tank Maidan. The All India Congress Committee launched a mass protest demanding what Gandhi called "An Orderly British Withdrawal" from India. Even though it was at war, the British were prepared to act. Almost the entire leadership of the Indian National Congress was imprisoned without trial within hours of Gandhi ji 's speech. Most spent the rest of the war in prison and out of contact with the masses. The British had the support of the Viceroy's Council (which had a majority of Indians), of the All-India Muslim League, the Hindu Mahasabha, the princely states, the Indian Imperial Police, the British Indian Army, and the Indian Civil Service. Many Indian businessmen profiting from heavy wartime spending did not support the Quit India Movement. Many students paid more attention to Subhas Chandra Bose, who was in exile and supporting the Axis Powers. The only outside support came from the Americans, as President Franklin D. Roosevelt pressured Prime Minister Winston Churchill to give in to some of the Indian demands. The Quit India campaign was effectively crushed. The British refused to grant immediate independence, saying it could happen only after the war had ended.

The Department of History and Political Science jointly celebrated Quit India movement Day on 08-08-2022 in our college. The departments arranged a meeting in which Dr.D.Chittibabu, principal, presided the meeting and spoke about the importance of the Quit India movement Day. Sri Hare Rama Krishna, Vice Principal, explained how the freedom fighters faced the struggle in those days. Smt. P.Tulasi kumari, Lecturer in History and Sri. S.Rajendra Prasad , Lecturer in Political Science, explains effects of Quit India movement. Other staff members and students participated and made it grand success.

In 2007 the United Nations General Assembly resolved to observe 15 September as the **International Day of Democracy**—with the purpose of promoting and upholding the principles of democracy—and invited all member states and organizations to commemorate the day in an appropriate manner that contributes to raising public awareness.

while democracies share common features, there is no single model of democracy and that democracy does not belong to any country or region... ..democracy is a universal value based on the freely-expressed will of people to determine their own political, economic, social and cultural systems, and their full participation in all aspects of life.

In September 1997 the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU) adopted a Universal Declaration on Democracy. That Declaration affirms the principles of democracy, the elements and exercise of democratic government, and the international scope of democracy.
