**Before starting the session, I would like**

**to share a few things about the webinar.**

**GST stands for Goods and Services Tax. The GST bill was introduced in Parliament on July 1, 2017. It is an Indirect tax which introduced to replacing a host of other Indirect taxes such as value added tax, service tax, purchase tax, excise duty, and so on. GST levied on the supply of certain goods and services in India. It is one tax that is applicable all over India.**

**The goods and services tax (GST) is a tax on goods and services sold domestically for consumption. The tax is included in the final price and paid by consumers at point of sale and passed to the government by the seller. ... The GST is usually taxed as a single rate across a nation.**

**In India, the idea of adopting GST was first suggested by the Atal Bihari Vajpayee Government in 2000. The state finance ministers formed an Empowered Committee (EC) to create a structure for GST, based on their experience in designing State VAT.**

**Vajpayee set up a committee headed by the Finance Minister of West Bengal, Asim Dasgupta to design a GST model. The Asim Dasgupta committee which was also tasked with putting in place the back-end technology and logistics (later came to be known as the GST Network, or GSTN, in 2015).**

**As per the newly implemented tax system,  
there are 4 different types of GST:**

**1.Integrated Goods and Services Tax [IGST]**

## **2. State Goods and Services Tax [SGST]**

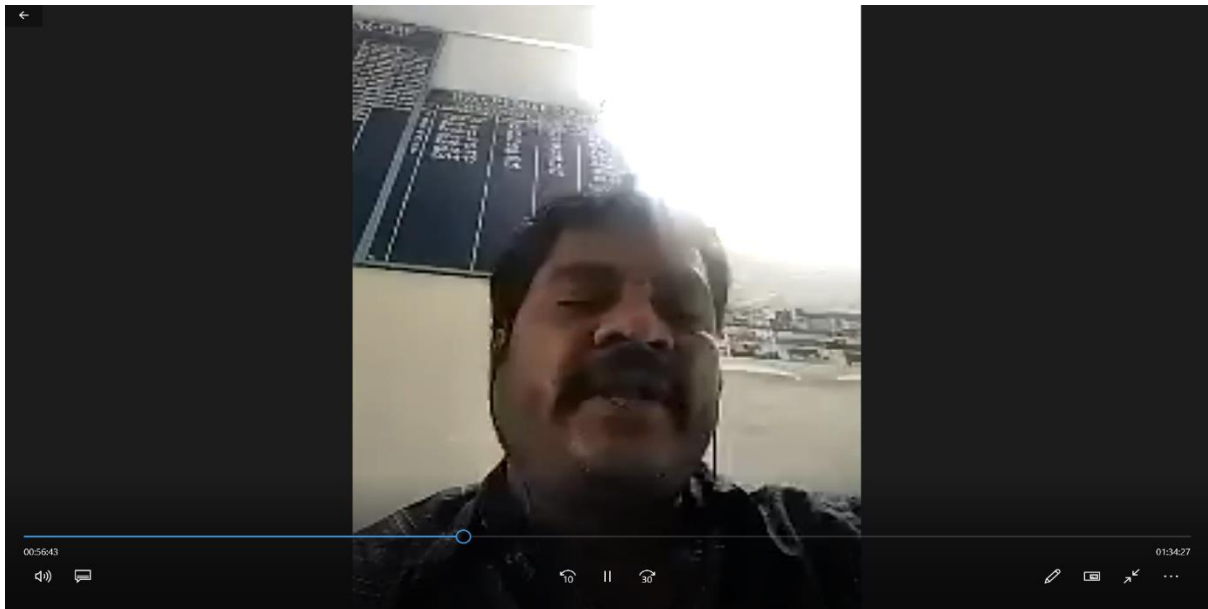
