On National Unity Day 2022, the Union Home Minister of India remembered Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on his 147th birth anniversary saying that the latter realised the dream of a strong and united India with his farsightedness.

Why is National Unity Day Celebrated?

- National Unity Day is celebrated every year on 31st October to commemorate the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. It is also known as Rastriya Ekta Diwas.
  - The reason behind the celebration of this day is to make people aware of the ideas of staying together and uplifting society.
  - It was celebrated for the first time in 2014.
- Several events are organised on this day like ‘Run for Unity’ - a nationwide marathon to increase awareness about the contribution of Sardar Patel to national integrity, National Unity pledge, etc.
- In 2018, the Government of India unveiled the ‘Statue of Unity’ in Gujarat to mark the 143rd birth anniversary of Sardar Patel.

What is the Statue of Unity?

- The Statue of Unity is the tallest statue in the world. At 182 meters, it is 23 meters taller than China's Spring Temple Buddha statue and almost double the height of the Statue of Liberty (93 meters tall) in the US.
- In January 2020, it was added to the ‘Eight Wonders’ of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO).

### Andhra Pradesh Formation Day History

During the colonial period, Andhra Pradesh was a part of the Madras Province. This is when the region witnessed a very solid movement for it to become an independent state

After this in 1953, the carving of the new state which is the regions of Rayalaseema and Andhra took place. In 1956, Telangana was added and Andhra Pradesh came into existence. Thus, Andhra Pradesh is the first state which was formed on a linguistic basis. This state is known to be the first of every state to have been formed on a linguistic basis.

It is also India's democracy. The primary goal of the election commission is to promote voter registration, especially among qualified voters. 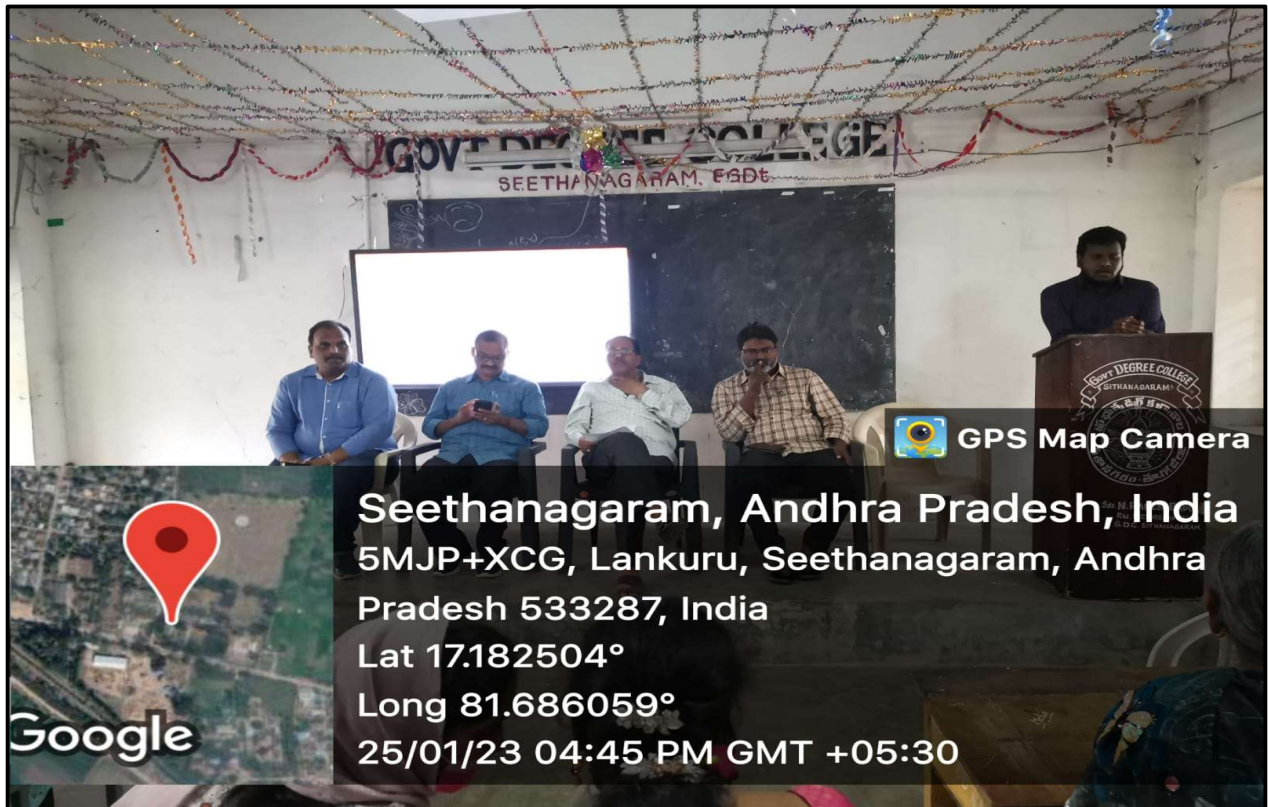

## ALLURI SITA RAMA RAJU

Born on 04 July 1897, in a village called Mogallu near Bhimavaram in Andhra Pradesh, Alluri Sitarama Raju was a sanyasi and a strong believer in justice who raised his voice and waged many a battle against unlawful British policies.

It is said that Sitarama Raju completed his initial years of schooling in his native village and then shifted to Visakhapatnam for his higher studies. By the age of 18, he renounced all worldly pleasures and became a sanyasi. He roamed the hills and forests of the Agency area as a *bala sanyasi* and mingled with the local tribal community. The tribals, in turn, regarded him as a mystic who would rescue them from their humiliating existence at the hands of the British authorities.

Initially, Sitarama Raju, under the influence of Gandhiji's Non-cooperation movement, inspired the tribals to seek justice in the local panchayat courts and boycott the colonial courts. However, these steps did not alleviate their suffering and eventually, he used the this movement to spread awareness about the need for change.

In August 1922, he launched what is now known as the Rampa Rebellion against the British. The Rampa administrative area was home to about 28,000 tribes. These tribes followed the '*Podu*' system of cultivation, whereby every year some amounts of forest tracts were cleared for cultivation, as it was their only source for food. While for the tribes, the forests were essential for their survival, the Britishers wanted to evict them so that they could plunder these areas for wood, which would eventually help in building their railways and ships.

He has left behind an inspiring legacy of anti-imperialist rebellion. Today, history remembers him as a fearless revolutionary, who, even though a non-tribal, who fought for the rights and freedom of the tribal people. He was honoured for his valour and fiery spirit with the title, "*Manyam Veerudu*" (Hero of the Jungle). Every year, the Government of Andhra Pradesh commemorates his birth date, the 4th of July, as a state festival.

## QUIT INDIA MOVEMENT

The **Quit India Movement**, also known as the **August Kranti Movement**, was a movement launched at the Bombay session of the All-India Congress Committee by Mahatma Gandhi on 8th August 1942, during World War II, demanding an end to British rule in India.

After the failure of the Cripps Mission to secure Indian support for the British war effort, Gandhi made a call to *Do or Die* in his Quit India speech delivered in Bombay on 8 August 1942 at the Gowalia Tank Maidan. The All India Congress Committee launched a mass protest demanding what Gandhi called "An Orderly British Withdrawal" from India. Even though it was at war, the British were prepared to act. Almost the entire leadership of the Indian National Congress was imprisoned without trial within hours of Gandhi ji 's speech. Most spent the rest of the war in prison and out of contact with the masses. The British had the support of the Viceroy's Council (which had a majority of Indians), of the All-India Muslim League, the Hindu Mahasabha, the princely states, the Indian Imperial Police, the British Indian Army, and the Indian Civil Service. Many Indian businessmen profiting from heavy wartime spending did not support the Quit India Movement. Many students paid more attention to Subhas Chandra Bose, who was in exile and supporting the Axis Powers. The only outside support came from the Americans, as President Franklin D. Roosevelt pressured Prime Minister Winston Churchill to give in to some of the Indian demands. The Quit India campaign was effectively crushed. The British refused to grant immediate independence, saying it could happen only after the war had ended.

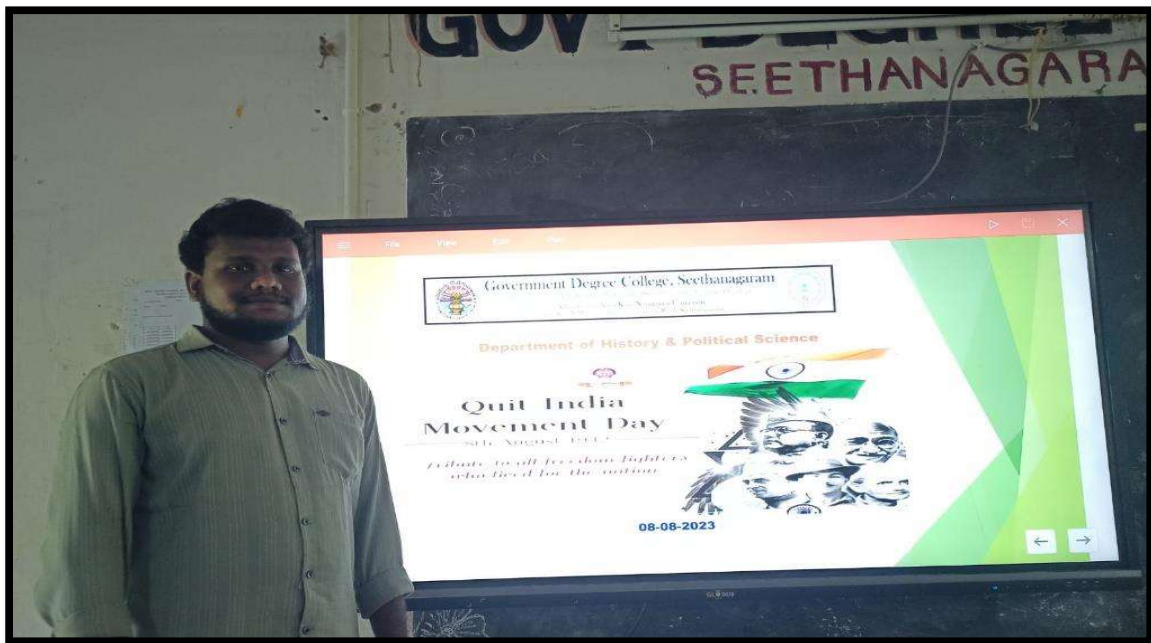
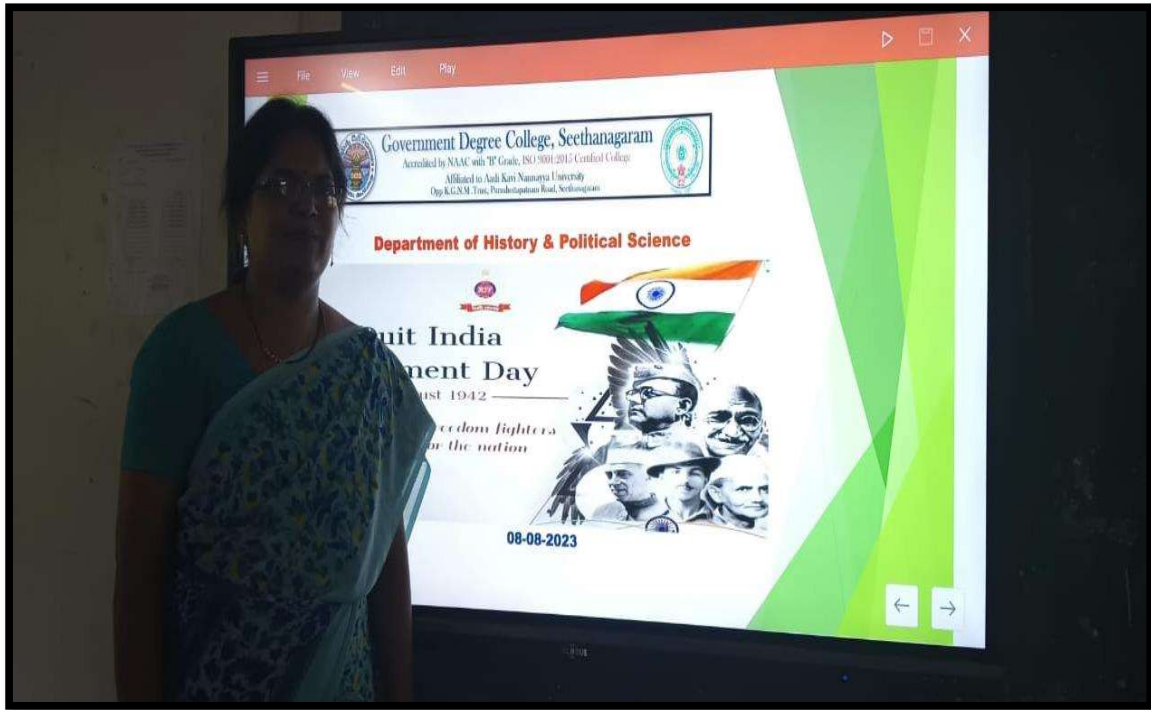

## **TANGUTURI PRAKSAM PANTHULU**

Tanguturi Prakasam Panthulu, popularly known as Andhra Kesari, is known as the most incorruptible politician. He was a jurist, freedom fighter, social reformer who gave away all what he earned to the poor. Born into a very poor Brahmin family on August 23, 1872, Prakasam Pantulu became the first chief minister of Andhra state, the first state to be formed on linguistic basis. Later, he played a prominent role in the formation of Andhra Pradesh.

He attained the title Andhra Kesari after bravely standing at gunpoint during a protest against the Simon Commission in Madras. Having lost his father at a very young age of 11 years, his mother took up the responsibility of earning for the family. Without sufficient income, Praksam used to have lunch at the houses of wealthy people. Returning to India, he practised law for sometime and gained popularity for criminal cases after he argued the Ash Murder Case. He earned well by practising law, but he left the profession and worked as the editor of Swarajya which was published in English, Telugu and Tamil languages simultaneously. He also ran a national-level school and a khadi production unit.

In 1921, he entered politics by getting elected as the president of the Andhra Region Congress Committee. In 1928, the Simon Commission did not allow protests in Madras. However, crowds gathered at the Madras High Court near Paris Corner and when the police opened fire to quell the mob, a youth named Parthasarathi died. The cops warned that anybody who would get near the body would also be shot but Prakasam tore his shirt and stood in front of the gun with his bare chest and dared the cops. His political life had several milestones -- he got elected as the chief minister of Madras on April 30, 1946. However, he remained as the CM only for 13 months. Setting aside his personal security, Prakasam met Razakar leader Qasim Rizvi in 1948 and warned him. Praising his bravery, the Razakars even bowed down to him in honour. On October 1, 1953, after Potti Sriramulu died staging indefinite hunger strike, Prakasam was nominated as the first chief minister of separate Andhra state. Though his services as the CM was remarkable, he could not continue in the position for more than 14 months. He quit active politics and passed away on May 20, 1957. He wrote his autobiography titled "The Journey of My Life". He was born poor but earned good money by practising law. However, he gave away all his money for the society and died poor. Surprisingly, his son worked as an attender in a college established in Andhra Kesari's name in Rajahmundry.

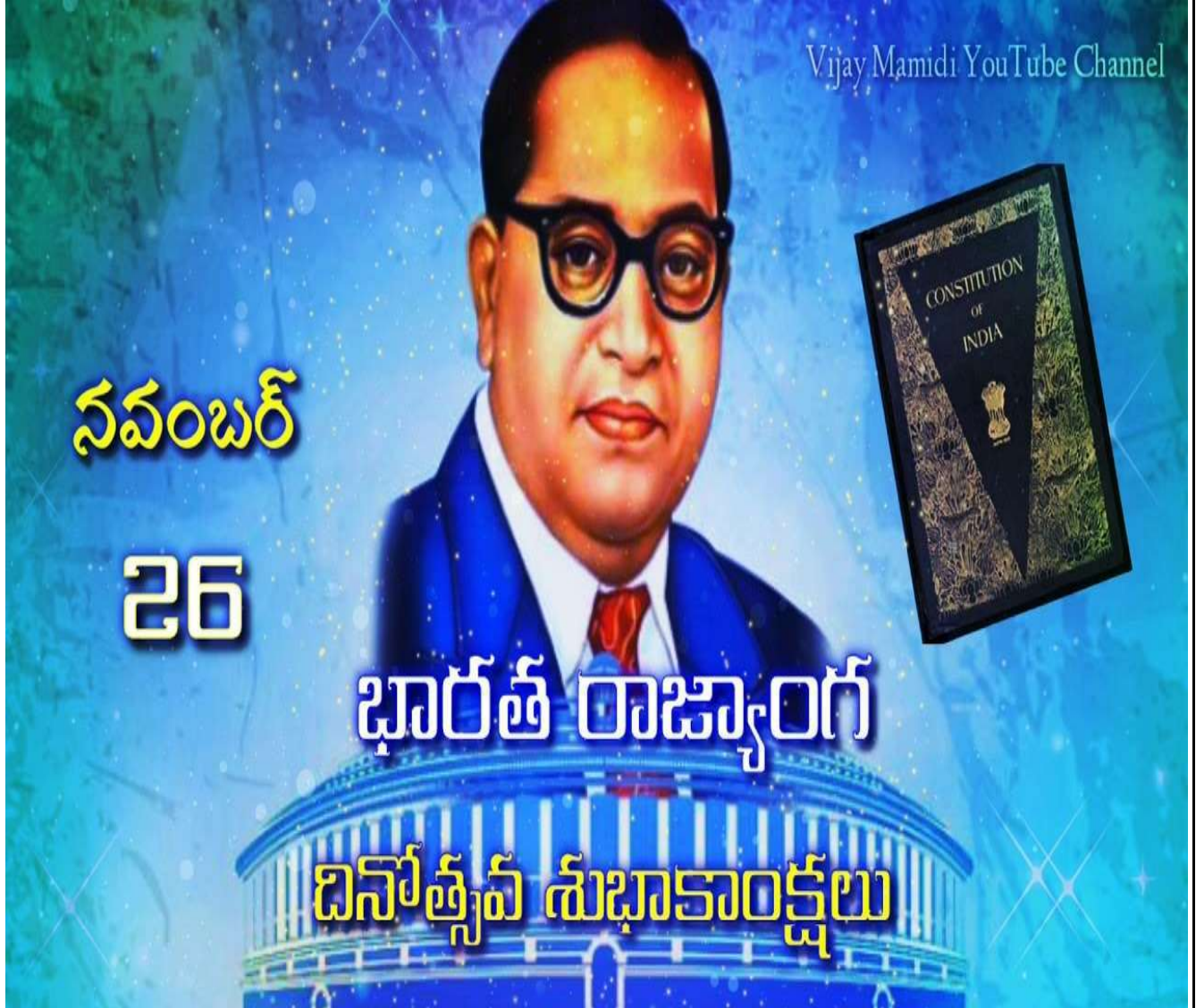
