National Voters' Day 2018: Ahead of the Republic Day on January 26, India is today (January 25) celebrating National Voters' Day. The theme of the National Voters' Day 2018 is 'Accessible Elections. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, on the occasion, has urged all eligible voters to register themselves and use their right to vote to strengthen democracy. In a tweet, he wrote, "Greetings to everyone on #NationalVotersDay. Congratulations to the Election Commission of India, which was founded on this day." He also attached a video in which he can be heard explaining his vision of New India – where there is harmony, peace, and prosperity for everyone. "I urge all the eligible voters, particularly youngsters, to register themselves and strengthen our democracy with their participation. The power of a vote is immense," said Modi, in another tweet.
