SCHOLARSHIP POLICY DOCUMENT

In order to provide necessary encouragement and motivation to pursue higher education the government is providing Scholarships to students of economically or socially backward classes studying at Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs). The Government Degree College, Seethanagaram follows a systematic procedure to ensure that these funds are efficiently deposited into their respective students' bank accounts.

Objectives:

- To reduce the financial stress on parents
- To have access to education without any financial barriers
- To promote equal opportunities in education
- To encourage meritorious students


Procedure for government scholarships

- The Principal of the college appoints an administrative staff to oversee and manage the disbursement of scholarships.
- A prompt notice will be circulated to all the students to apply for scholarship.
- To initiate the process, students are registered on the Jnanabhoomi portal by providing their SSC score and year of passing as the required details.
- This registered students' list is then forwarded to social welfare office upon biometric authentication of the student.
- Both soft copy and hard copy of the details are maintained.
- An efficient mechanism is followed by class proctors to calculate the class attendance of the student on monthly basis.
- Subsequently, this attendance list is forwarded to the social welfare office on monthly basis.
- One Time Password (OTP) authentication by the College Principal is required to confirm and save the monthly attendance of the student in the portal.
- To be eligible for a scholarship, it is mandatory for students to have a minimum attendance of 75%.
- The funds will be released on quarterly basis considering the monthly attendance and social, economic background status of the student.
- The same procedure is followed for all the terms.

Apart from the government scholarships, Endowment Prizes are also awarded to students who show excellence in academics. The donated funds by philanthropists are deposited in a bank, and the annual interest generated is distributed equally among all the awardees, ensuring a fair and unbiased allocation.

Procedure for Endowment prizes

- Students are selected by the selection committee to award the merit prizes.
- One prize each for students who secure highest marks in all semesters from each program namely, Bachelor of Arts (BA), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com), Bachelor of Science (B.Sc) become eligible for the award.
- One prize for students who secure highest marks in Economics in first year across all programmes
- The interest drawn annually on the amount deposited is equally distributed to all the awardees without any bias.
- Signature of the students is taken as acknowledgement after awarding the prize money
