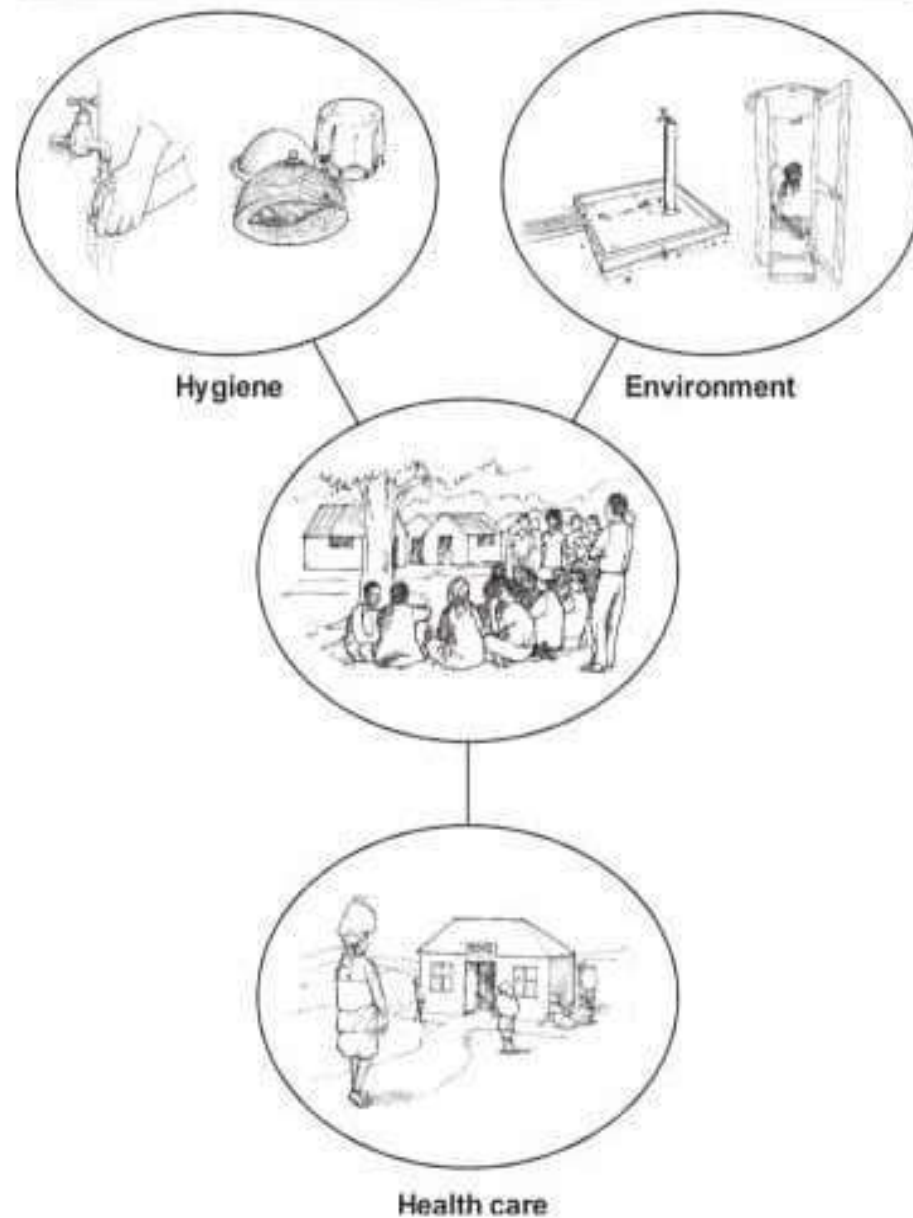

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NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

STUDENTS VACCINATION PROGRAMME

03-01-2022

There are several COVID-19 vaccines validated for use by WHO (given Emergency Use Listing). The first mass vaccination programme started in early December 2020 and the number of vaccination doses administered is updated on a daily basis on the COVID-19 dashboard.

The WHO Emergency Use Listing process determines whether a product can be recommended for use based on all the available data on safety and efficacy and on its suitability in low- and middle-income countries. Vaccines are assessed to ensure they meet acceptable standards of quality, safety, and efficacy using clinical trial data, manufacturing, and quality control processes. The assessment weighs the threat posed by the emergency as well as the benefit that would accrue from the use of the product against any potential risks.

In line with their national regulations and legislation, countries have the autonomy to issue emergency use authorizations for any health product. Domestic emergency use authorizations are issued at the discretion of countries and not subject to WHO approval.

Our college NSS Unit and Department of Zoology jointly organized Mega Vaccination Drive for our students in collaboration with local PHC on 3rd January 2021. Sri Jakkampudi Raja, MLA inaugurated the Drive and Principal Dr D.Chittibabu, NSS Co-Ordinator Sri S. Rajendra Prasad, HoD of Zoology Smt. A. Vani and other staff members coordinated the programme. Nearly 150 students were vaccinated with Covaxine.

In 1909, the first Women's Day was observed across the United States. In 1910, an international conference of working women was held in Copenhagen. That's where the idea was proposed by Clara Zetkin, a leader of the Women's Office for the Social Democratic Party in Germany. In 1911, International Women's Day was honoured for the first time in Austria, Denmark, Germany and Switzerland on 19 March. Between 1913 and 1914, women in Russia observed their first Women's Day on February 23. Later, it was decided that March 8 can be the globally accepted day to celebrate IWD. International Women's Day was celebrated for the first time by the United Nations in 1975.

Colours of International Women's Day

Did you know there are also colours for the day? The three colours are purple, green and white. Purple signifies justice and dignity, green symbolizes hope and white represents purity, which was slightly marred by controversy. The colours originated from the Women's Social and Political Union (WSPU) in the UK in the year 1908.

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Child marriage refers to the marriage of a child younger than 18 years old, in accordance to Article 1 of the Convention on the Right of the Child. In simple terms, child marriage is the marriage of a person aged before majority. As a derivative interpretation of several international documents, it is a violation of human rights.² While child marriage affects both sexes, girls are disproportionately affected as they are the majority of the victims. Child marriage and child betrothal are oftentimes practices that are related to customary and religious beliefs, along with a lot of relevant economic considerations. They occur globally, in many parts of Africa and Asia and to some extent in the Americas. Globally, 36 per cent of women aged 20–24 were married or in union before they reached 18 years of age.³ An estimated 14 million adolescents between 15 and 19 give birth each year. Girls in this age group are twice as likely to die during pregnancy or childbirth as women in their twenties.⁴

Most often an arranged marriage, children, especially girls, are married off early – sometimes just after puberty, and sometimes even before – so as to bring the family some monetary earning. In many communities, a young girl brings in a lot of dowry – it doesn't matter that these girls may be too young to marry, it doesn't matter that the man she is married off to, is easily double, triple or even four times her age. These communities place significant emphasis on the fact that a woman is not allowed, or is deemed incapable of being educated or working. There is also a belief that women must reproduce early enough because they have a shorter reproductive life period in relative comparison with men.⁵ In many parts of Asia and Africa, families give birth to many children so that enough of them survive, and enough of them help by being more hands to work. If these children are sons, these families deem them economically viable assets to the family. 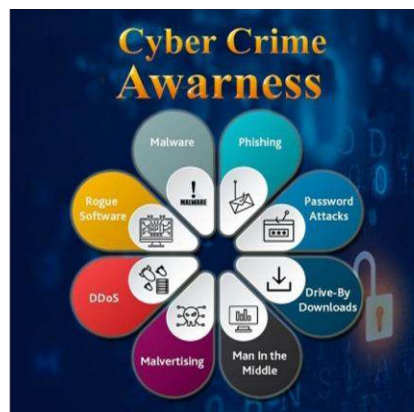

A Brief Study on Cyber Crime and Cyber Law's of India

INTRODUCTION

The invention of Computer has made the life of humans easier, it has been using for various purposes starting from the individual to large organizations across the globe. In simple term we can define computer as the machine that can stores and manipulate/process information or instruction that are instructed by the user. It doesn't have a fixed definition, but in a simple term we can defined it as the law that governs the cyberspace. Cyber laws are the laws that govern cyber area. Cyber Crimes, digital and electronic signatures, data protections and privacies etc are comprehended by the Cyber Law [3]. The UN's General Assembly recommended the first IT Act of India which was based on the "United Nations Model Law on Electronic Commerce"

OBJECTIVE

The principle target of our paper is to spread the knowledge of the crimes or offences that take place through the internet or the cyberspace, along with the laws that are imposed against those crimes and criminals. We are additionally trying to focus on the safety in cyberspace.

CYBER CRIME AND CYBER LAW

We can define "Cyber Crime" as any malefactor or other offences where electronic communications or information systems, including any device or the Internet or both or more of them are involved . We can define "Cyber law" as the legal issues that are related to utilize of communications technology, concretely "cyberspace", i.e. the Internet. It is an endeavor to integrate the challenges presented by human action on the Internet with legacy system of laws applicable to the physical world .

Cyber Crime

Sussman and Heuston first proposed the term "Cyber Crime" in the year 1995. Cybercrime cannot be described as a single definition, it is best considered as a collection of acts or conducts. These acts are based on the material offence object that affects the computer data or systems. These are the illegal acts where a digital device or information system is a tool or a target or it can be the combination of both. The cybercrime is also known as electronic crimes, computer-related crimes, e-crime, high- technology crime,

information age crime etc.

In simple term we can describe "Cyber Crime" are the offences or crimes that takes place over electronic communications or information systems. These types of crimes are basically the illegal activities in which a computer and a network are involved. Due of the development of the internet, the volumes of the cybercrime activities are also increasing because when committing a crime there is no longer a need for the physical present of the criminal.

History of Cyber Crime

The first Cyber Crime was recorded within the year 1820. The primeval type of computer has been in Japan, China and India since 3500 B.C, but Charles Babbage's analytical engine is considered as the time of present day computers. In the year 1820, in France a textile manufacturer named Joseph-Marie Jacquard created the loom. This device allowed a series of steps that was continual within the weaving of special fabrics or materials. This resulted in an exceeding concern among the Jacquard's workers that their livelihoods as well as their traditional employment were being threatened, and prefer to sabotage so as to discourage Jacquard so that the new technology cannot be utilized in the future

Evolution of Cyber Crime

The cyber crime is evolved from Morris Worm to the ransom ware. Many countries including India are working to stop such crimes or attacks, but these attacks are continuously changing and affecting our nation.

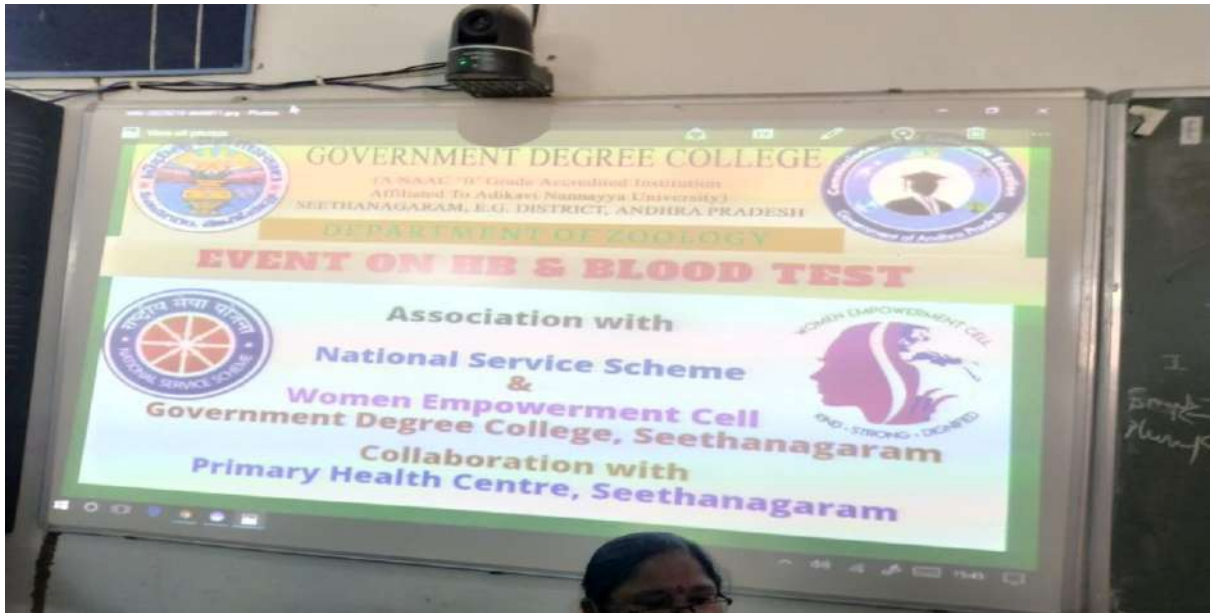

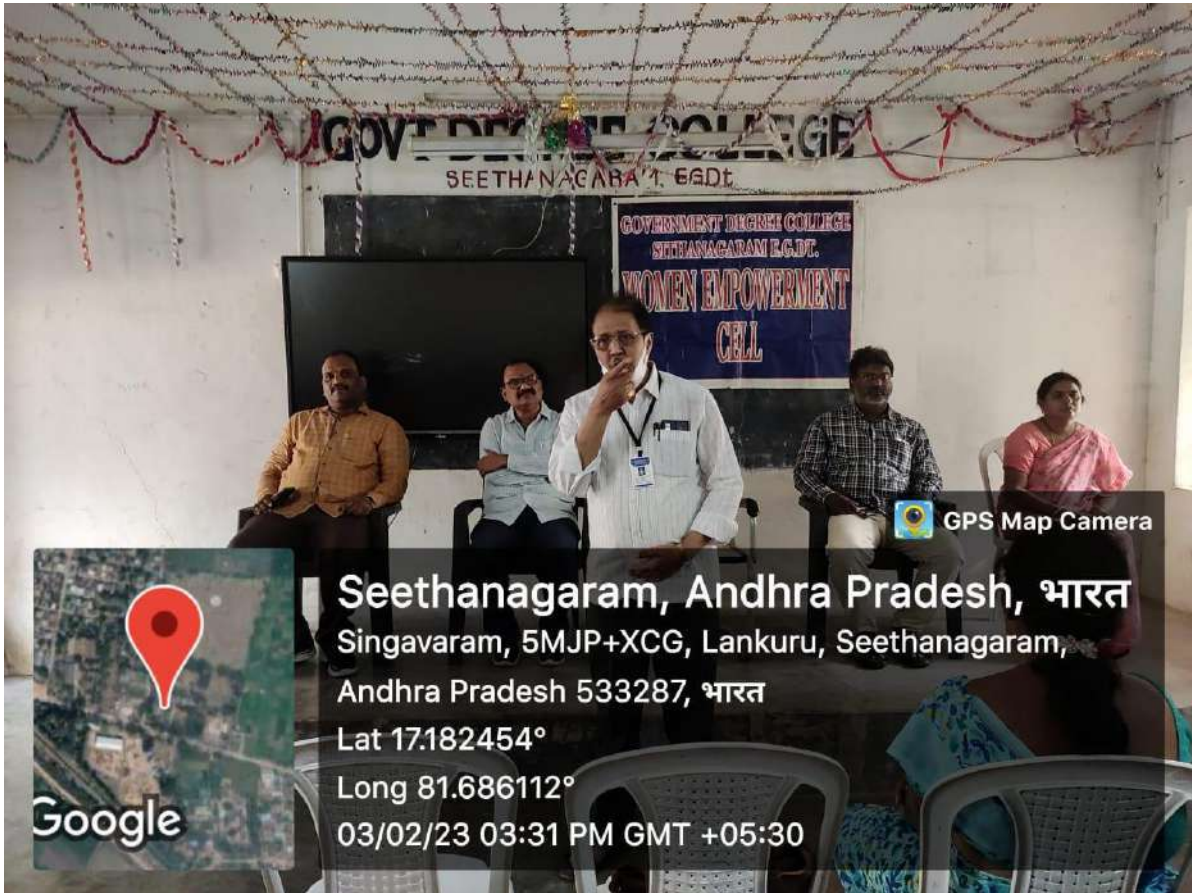

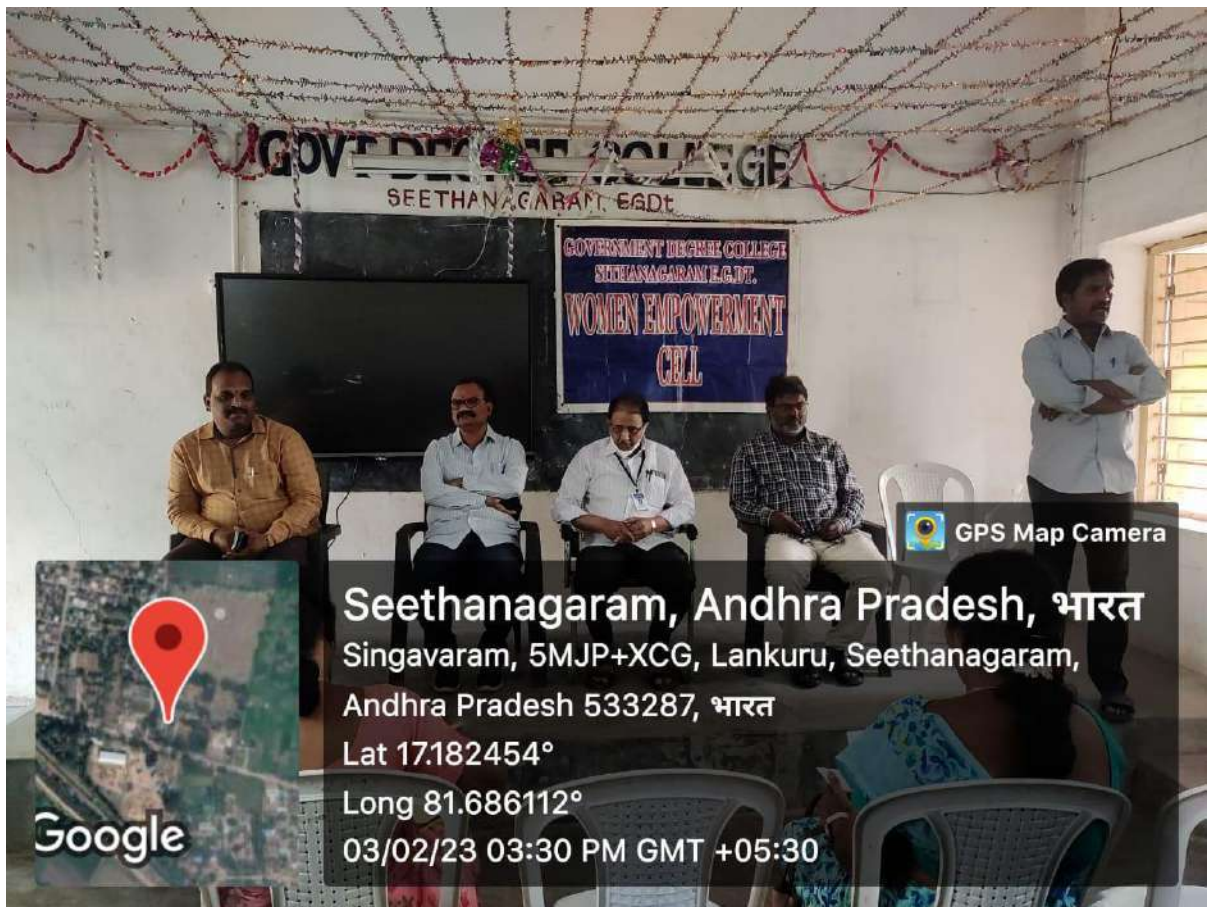

By 2050, 75% of jobs will be related to STEM areas. Yet today, women hold just 22% of positions in artificial intelligence, to name just one.

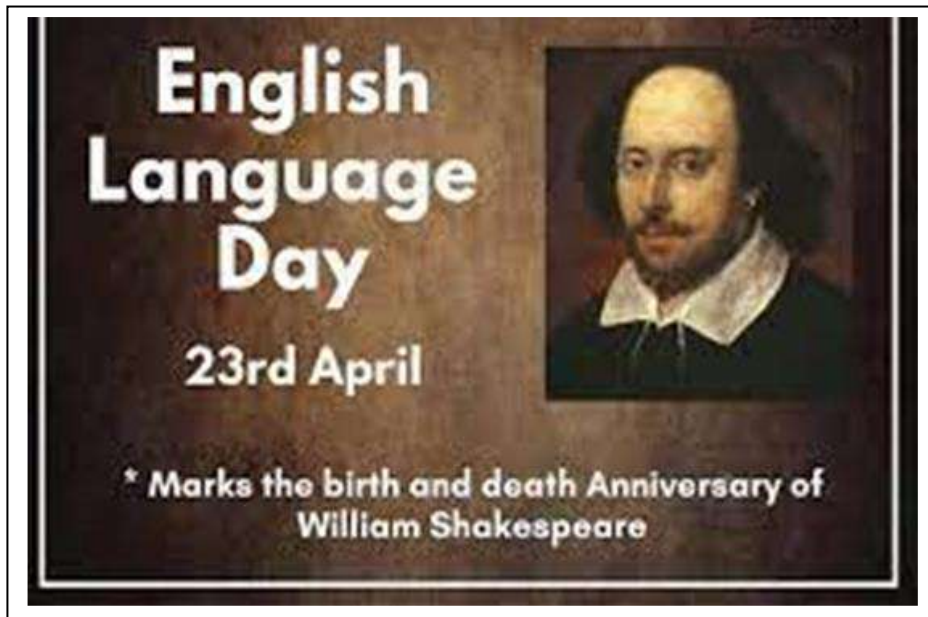
The origins of English:

The spread of English

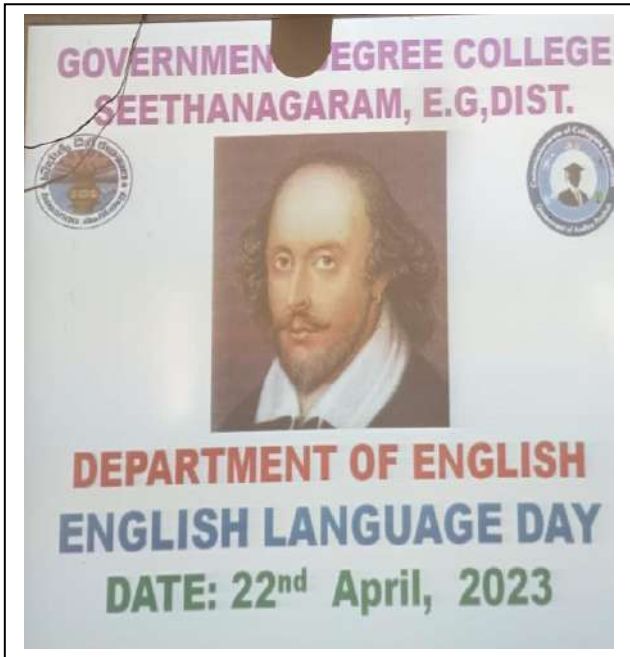

INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY



21st FEBRUARY 2022

THEME: Multilingual education – a necessity to transform education

Synopsis:

On February 21, 1952, students and activists in East Pakistan (now Bangladesh) protested against the Pakistani government's decision to impose Urdu as the only official language of the country. During the protest, police opened fire on the demonstrators, killing several of them.

The protest and the subsequent violence that followed became a turning point in the struggle for independence for East Pakistan, and it gave rise to a movement to promote the Bengali language and culture.

In 1999, the Government of Bangladesh proposed to UNESCO that February 21st be declared as International Mother Language Day to commemorate the events of 1952 and to promote linguistic and cultural diversity around the world. The proposal was accepted by UNESCO, and International Mother Language Day was first observed on February 21, 2000.

Background :

International Mother Language Day was proclaimed by the General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) in November 1999. The idea to celebrate International Mother Language Day was the initiative of Bangladesh. The UN General Assembly welcomed the proclamation of the day in its resolution of 2002.

On 16 May 2007 the United Nations General Assembly in its resolution A/RES/61/266 called upon Member States "to promote the preservation and protection of all languages used by peoples of the world". By the same resolution, the General Assembly proclaimed 2008 as the **International Year of Languages**, to promote unity in diversity and international understanding, through multilingualism and multiculturalism and named the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization to serve as the lead agency for the Year.

Today there is growing awareness that languages play a vital role in development, in ensuring cultural diversity and intercultural dialogue, but also in strengthening co-operation and attaining quality education for all, in building inclusive knowledge societies and preserving cultural heritage, and in mobilizing political will for applying the benefits of science and technology to sustainable development.

**“Using technology for multilingual learning:
Challenges and opportunities”**

HISTORY & SIGNIFICANCE:

English Language Day was first marked by the United Nations' Department of Global Communications in 2010 as part of an initiative for establishing language days for each of the UN's six official languages. An interesting fact that needs to be noted is that 1500 years ago, only three tribes spoke English, whereas now it is spoken by around 2 billion people. About 75 countries have given official status to this language.

ABOUT THE DAY:

English Language Day is observed annually on April 23, the aim is to celebrate multilingualism and cultural diversity by exploring the language. English Language Day marks both the birthday and date of the death of famed writer William Shakespeare. English is one of the most popular languages used across the world.

ABOUT WILLIAM SHAKESPEARE:

William Shakespeare (23 April 1564 – 23 April 1616) was an English playwright, poet and actor. He is widely regarded as the greatest writer in the English language and the world's greatest dramatist. He is often called England's national poet and the "Bard of Avon" (or simply "the Bard"). His extant works, including collaborations, consist of some 39 plays, 154 sonnets, three long narrative poems, and a few other verses, some of uncertain authorship. His plays have been translated into every major living language and are performed more often than those of any other playwright. His works continue to be studied and reinterpreted.

Shakespeare was born and raised in Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire. At the age of 18, he married Anne Hathaway, with whom he had three children: Susanna and twins Hamlet and Judith. Sometime between 1585 and 1592, he began a successful career in London as an actor, writer, and part-owner of a playing company called the Lord Chamberlain's Men, later known as the King's Men. At age 49 (around 1613), he appears to have retired to Stratford, where he died three years later. Few records of Shakespeare's private life survive; this has stimulated considerable speculation about such matters as his physical appearance, his sexuality, his religious beliefs and whether the works attributed to him were written by others.

Shakespeare produced most of his known works between 1589 and 1613. His early plays were primarily comedies and histories and are regarded as some of the best works produced in these genres. He then wrote mainly tragedies until 1608, among them Hamlet, Romeo and Juliet, Othello, King Lear, and Macbeth, all considered to be among the finest works in the English

language. In the last phase of his life, he wrote tragicomedies (also known as romances) and collaborated with other playwrights.

Many of Shakespeare's plays were published in editions of varying quality and accuracy in his lifetime. However, in 1623, two fellow actors and friends of Shakespeare's, John Heminges and Henry Condell, published a more definitive text known as the First Folio, a posthumous collected edition of Shakespeare's dramatic works that included all but two of his plays. Its Preface was a prescient poem by Ben Jonson that hailed Shakespeare with the now famous epithet: "not of an age, but for all time".

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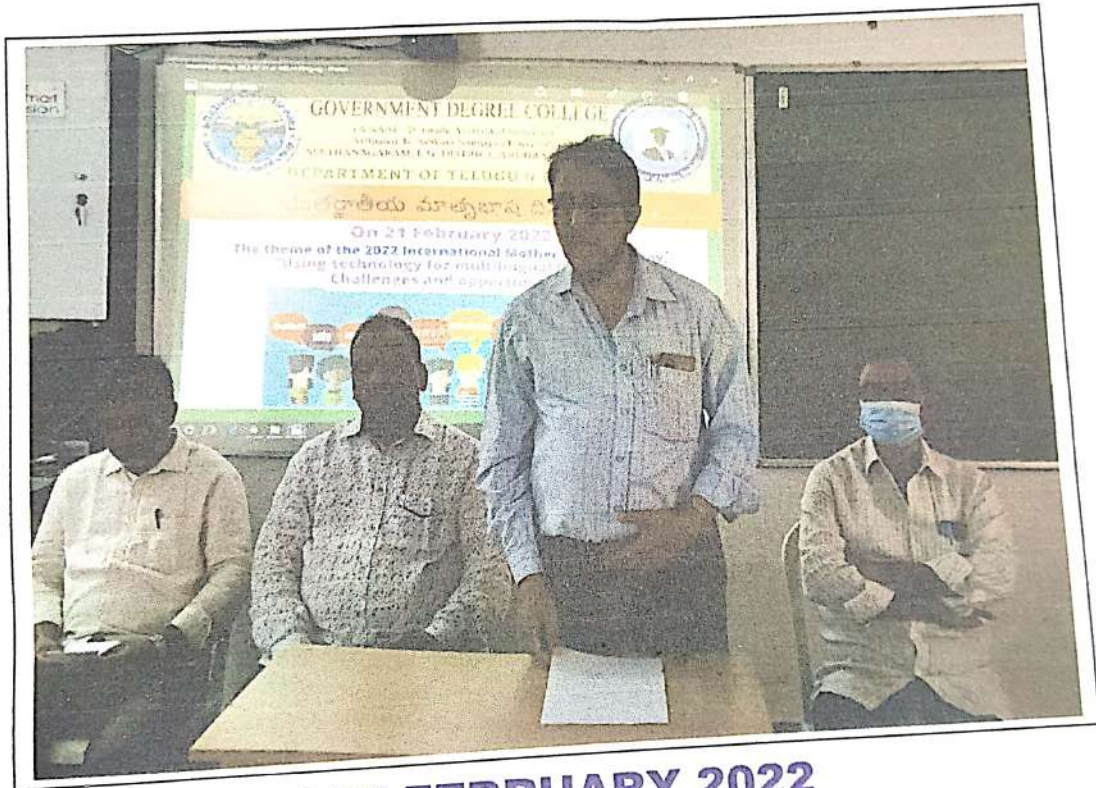

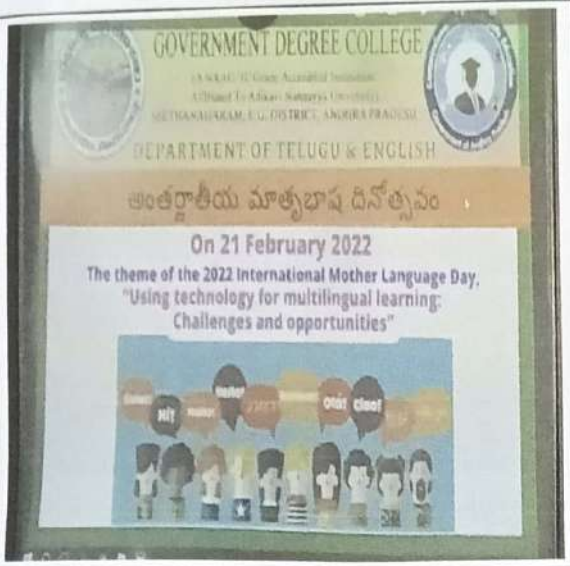

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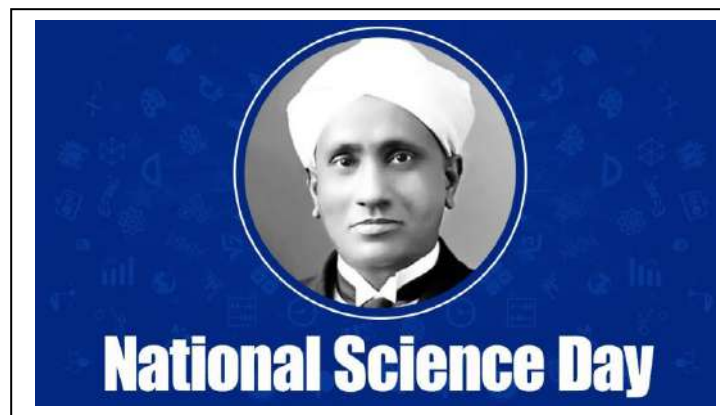

About National Science Day

National Science Day 2023 Theme “Global Science for Global Wellbeing”

India celebrates National Science Day on February 28 every year to mark the contributions of scientists towards the development of the country. On this day, in 1928, Indian Physicists Sir CV Raman made an important discovery in the field of spectroscopy, which was later named after him - the Raman Effect. For this discovery, he was also awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930.

Raman Effect is the phenomenon in spectroscopy discovered by Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman while working in the laboratory of the Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science, Kolkata.

History:

The National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC), in 1986, asked the Government of India to announce February 28 as National Science Day. The government accepted and declared the day National Science Day. The first National Science Day was celebrated on February 28, 1987.

Objective:

National Science Day's primary objective is to ignite an interest in science, inspire people, especially students, to perform new experiments, and make them aware of the latest developments in science and technology. Several scientific activities and programs are organized on this day.

Significance:

National Science Day is celebrated to raise awareness of the importance of science. Educational institutions celebrate National Science Day by organizing public speeches, radio, TV, science movies, science exhibitions on themes and concepts, debates, quiz competitions, lectures and science model exhibitions.

How Do We Celebrate This Day?

On this day, various efforts and achievements in science are celebrated, and dialogues are held on the implementation of new technologies. Students of institutes all over the country demonstrate different science projects, and the national and state-level science institutions display their latest research. The celebration also includes public speeches, radio and TV talk shows, exhibitions of science movies, science exhibitions based on different themes and concepts, events for watching the night sky, quiz competitions, debates, and many more such activities.

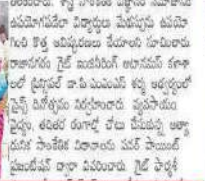

ABOUT NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY:

National Science Day (NSD) is celebrated in India on **28 February** each year to mark the discovery of the **Raman Effect** by Indian physicist **Sir C. V. Raman** on 28 February 1928. The government of India designated 28 February as National Science Day (NSD) in 1986. The National Science Day is spread the message about the importance of science in the daily life of the people. On this day, speech, debated, science exhibitions, Essay Writing, quiz competitions, lectures and science model exhibitions etc. is organized in schools, colleges, universities and other academic institutions across the country.



Raman Effect

The National Science Day theme for 2022:

'Integrated Approach in Science & Technology for Sustainable Future'.

Here are nine lesser-known facts about Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman:

- CV Raman, a gifted child, was born in **1888** in Thiruvanaikaval, Tiruchi, and completed his schooling in Visakhapatnam before enrolling in The Presidency College, which was part of the University of Madras, for a B.A. programme in 1903 when he was just 14 years old.
- While working in the laboratory of the **Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science** in Kolkata, physicist CV Raman discovered the Raman Effect.
- On February 28, 1928, Indian Scientist Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman announced the discovery of the **'Raman Effect.'**
- CV Raman received the coveted **Nobel Prize in Physics for his discovery.**
- To honour the renowned scientist, India has commemorated this day as **National Science Day since 1987.**
- **In 1954**, CV Raman was awarded the **Bharat Ratna**, which is the highest civilian honour in India.
- CV Raman was an expert in the field of light scattering and was always engaged in research.
- Professor Raman was a top student for most of his academic career, and he went on to make significant contributions to the fields of acoustics and optics.
- CV Raman was also a remarkable teacher, and in 1917 he was named the **first Palit Professor of Physics at the Rajabazar Science College.**

“Avogadro's Number, a measuring unit in chemistry”

Amedeo Avogadro was an Italian physicist. In 1811, he proposed that equal volumes of any gas at the same temperature and pressure contain the same number of atoms (or molecules).

Mole Day is celebrated among chemists, chemistry students and chemistry enthusiasts on October 23, between 6:02 a.m. and 6:02 p.m., making the date 6:02 10/23.

Avogadro number or Avogadro's constant is denoted as 6.022×10^{23} to define the number of particles present in a single mole of any substance.

The theme of National Mole Day 2021

Every year there are specific mole day themes announced. The theme for Mole Day the year 2020 was MOLEzilla. It is a special day for all the persons associated with the subject of chemistry. Many activities related to moles and chemistry are conducted to mark this day. There is no national mole day 2021 theme yet but the objective of this day remains the same.

Interesting facts about National Mole Day 2021

On Mole Day, let us know more about the timeline from the establishment of the mole as the unit for measurement to other important events related to this day. Try participating in various mole day activities happening near you.

1. It was in 1811 when Avogadro made the first hypothesis that equal volumes of nitrogen and hydrogen maintained under the same pressure and temperature will have the same molecular count.
2. The credit for this discovery was awarded to Avogadro only after his death, unfortunately.
3. In the year 1985, Margaret Christoph, a science teacher from Delaware mentions celebrating a day for chemistry with her students in the month of October. She cites this as a day filled with chemistry-related activities every year.
4. The celebration was mentioned in an article in "The Science Teacher".
5. Inspired by this article, the National Mole Day was started in the year 1991 by another high school teacher of Chemistry, Maurice Oehler.
6. The National Chemistry Week sponsored by the American Chemical Society also falls in the month of October which has the Mole Day in the week making it an important event for the Chemistry week itself.
7. In the year 2017, an ode to the franchise of the Avengers Superheroes was created under the name "mol Evengers"
8. 10^6 or as low as 10^{-2} .

National Pollution Prevention Day

History:

National Pollution Prevention Day is observed annually on December 2 in memory of the people who lost their lives in the 1984 Bhopal Gas Tragedy. The horrific industrial accident took place due to the leak of Methyl Isocyanate gas in the Union Carbide India Limited (UCIL) pesticide plant on the night of December 2-3. Thousands of people were killed due to the toxic gas spread. Bhopal gas tragedy is said to be one of the world's worst industrial disasters to date. The aftereffects of the tragedy were also very severe as increased cases of cancer and birth defects were reported. Here's all you need to know about the day.

OBJECTIVES:

The Bhopal gas tragedy showed that the pollution and presence of toxic gases in the environment can be hazardous. Hence, the day is not only observed in honour of people who lost their lives in the deadly tragedy but also to spread awareness on managing and controlling industrial disasters, preventing the pollution produced by industrial processes or human negligence.

HOW TO CONTROL POLLUTION:

1. Don't burn waste in a crowded area as the smoke leads to severe health damage and breathing issues. Promote the use of renewable energy and recyclable products

2. Enhance plantations by opting for urban forests and green roofs to reduce pollution in urban areas.
3. Avoid wastage of electricity, water and other natural resources.
4. Don't dump garbage or waste in rivers or water bodies.

About Ozone Day

The theme of World Ozone Day 2022 is '**Global Cooperation to Protect Life on Earth**'.

International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer (informally and simply called **Ozone Day**) is celebrated on September 16 designed by the United Nations General Assembly. This designation had been made on December 19, 2000, in commemoration of the date, in 1987, on which nations signed the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer.

World Ozone Day is observed on September 16 every year to spread awareness among people about the depletion of Ozone Layer and find possible solutions to preserve it. On this day, **people from all over the world hold talks and seminars on the ozone layer.**

Ozone is a layer of Oxygen (O₃) molecules in the stratosphere that protects us from harmful sun rays. It gets depleted by some chemical elements that are usually the consequence of the human intervention. Hence it becomes our obligation to conserve the layer so that we stay protected from harmful rays. World Ozone Day is a day dedicated to planning, formulating, and enacting toward preserving the Ozone layer.

- **Causes** – Ozone Depleting Substances (ODS) such as Chlorine and Bromine are the prime cause of ozone layer depletion. These form Chlorofluoro Carbons (CFCs) due to human activities and cause the ozone to deplete.
- **Effects** – Ozone layer depletion allows UV rays from the sun to enter the earth's surface. These rays cause global warming and make it hard for living organisms to survive. It also hinders the natural cycles and causes cancer, skin ailments, etc.
- **Prevention** – To prevent the degradation of ozone, we must reduce the use of CFCs, reduce air pollutants, and plant trees.
- The ozone is a highly reactive gas and makes the Ozone shield.
- A single molecule of chlorine can break down thousands of ozone molecules.

The ozone layer is a thin layer of gas in the Earth's atmosphere that absorbs most of the Sun's ultraviolet (UV) radiation. It is noteworthy for several reasons, comprising:

- **Protection from harmful UV radiation:** The ozone layer protects life on Earth from the harmful effects of UV radiation, which can cause skin cancer, cataracts, and other health problems in humans and animals.
- **Regulating Earth's temperature:** The ozone layer helps regulate Earth's temperature by absorbing some of the sun's heat, which keeps the planet from becoming too hot or too cold.
- **Supporting food production:** The ozone layer protects crops from excessive UV radiation, which can damage plant DNA and reduce crop yields.
- **Preserving marine life:** The ozone layer protects marine life by reducing the amount of UV radiation that penetrates the ocean, which can damage marine ecosystems.

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.



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INTRODUCTION:

V.K. R.V. Rao, the father of NSS. NSS provides opportunity to the student youth of 11th & 12th Class of schools at +2 Board level and student youth of Technical Institution, Graduate & Post Graduate at colleges and University level of India to take part in various Government led community service activities & programmes. NSS was launched in 1969 in 37 Universities involving about 40,000 volunteers which has now spread over 657 Universities and 51 +2 Councils/Directorates, covering 20,669 Colleges/ Technical Institutions and 11,988 Senior Secondary School. Since inception, over 7.4 crore students have benefitted from NSS.

NSS DAY:

- Every year 24th September is celebrated as NSS Day.

NSS AIM:

- Facilitate personality development of students through social and community service.
- To identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in the problem-solving process.
- Encouraging youth to participate enthusiastically in the process of national development and promote national integration through corporate living and cooperative action.
- Personality Development of students through community service.

NSS OBJECTIVES:

The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are:

- The primary objective of developing the personality and character of the student youth through voluntary community service.
- To understand the community in which they work.
- To understand themselves in relation to their community
- To develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility
- To gain skills in mobilising community participation
- To acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes
- To develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters
- To practise national integration and social harmony

NSS MOTO:

The Motto of NSS "Not Me But You," reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for self-less service.

NSS SYMBOL:



The NSS symbol is based on the "Rath" wheel of the Konark Sun Temple situated in Odisha.

- The navy blue colour indicates the cosmos of which the NSS is a tiny part, ready to contribute its share for the welfare of the mankind.
- The Red colour in the badge indicates that the NSS volunteers are full of blood i.e. lively, active, energetic and full of high spirit.

The giant wheels of the Sun Temple portray the cycle of creation, preservation and release, and signify the movement in life across time and space.

NSS PLEDGE:

- "I solemnly pledge to work with dedication to Serve and strengthen freedom and integrity of the nation. I further affirm that I shall never resort to Violence and that all differences and disputes relating the religion, language, region or political or economic grievance should be settled by peaceful and constitutional mean."

NSS PROGRAMMES:

- National Service Scheme has two types of programmes:
- Regular Activities and Special Camping Programmes. Students enrolled as NSS Volunteers are expected to work in the scheme for a period of two years and also participate in Special Camping Programmes of 10 days duration.

- **Regular Activities:**

NSS volunteer undertake various activities in campus adopted, villages and slumps for community service. Duration of these service is 120 hours ie. 20 hours for orientation of NSS volunteers, 30 hours for campus work and 70 hours for community service. In regular NSS programmes students undertake various activities in the college campuses, adopted villages, cities and slums during weekends. Adoption of a village or an area is a meaningful programme in NSS.

- **Special Programmes:**

Special Camping Programme is a camp of ten days duration in adopted places and it provides unique opportunities to the students for group living, collective experience sharing, sharing responsibilities, addressing various developmental issues of regional and national importance and constant interaction with the community. 50 percentage NSS volunteers are expected to participate in these camps.

ENROLMENT IN NSS:

NSS is a voluntary scheme. NSS scheme starts from 11th Standard onwards. At college level the NSS volunteers will be enrolled from the first and second year degree-class students. The students from foreign countries studying in Indian universities can also join NSS so that they may share the experiences of national reconstruction and community work. NCC cadets will not be allowed to join NSS. Similarly NSS volunteers will not participate in NCC or any other youth organisation as long as they are in NSS.

An NSS volunteer needs to devote a total of 240 hours social service in two years duration. Every year, a NSS volunteer has to devote 20 hrs. of orientation and 100 hrs. of community service. To enrol as NSS volunteer, contact the NSS Programme Officer of your college. Enrollment in NSS is free. The NSS volunteers on successful completion of the required hours of service are issued a certificate. NSS volunteers can get some weightage during admissions in higher studies and other benefits as decided by the institutions/university.

The College has one NSS Unit with a total strength of 100 student Volunteers.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR NSS VOLUNTEERS:

- All volunteers shall work under the guidance of a group leader nominated by the program officer.
- They shall make themselves worthy of the confidence and co-operation of the group/ community leadership.
- They shall scrupulously avoid entering into any controversial issues.
- They shall keep day-to-day record of their activities/experience in the enclosing pages of the diary and submit to the Group Leader/ Programme Officer for periodic guidance.
- It is obligatory and part of every volunteer to wear the NSS BADGE while on the work.
